

Fundraising ideas

Hold your own fundraising event

- **Zumbathon** – are you a Zumba instructor or do you attend a Zumba class? Why not organise a Zumbathon at your local gym or community hall and charge £10 to take part?
- **Sporty** – hold a fundraiser at your local tennis, golf, rugby or football club. Get everyone dressed in pink and then put on a lovely big pink tea afterwards.
- **Food and drink** – organise and sell tickets to a curry night, cheese and wine evening, BBQ or a coffee morning selling home-made pink cakes.
- **Pink ball** – organise a pink ball for all your friends and family and get everyone to wear an item of pink.
- **Test your knowledge** – host a quiz evening or mastermind tournament and sell tickets to take part.



Family and friends

- **Use your talents** – you could cut your neighbours' lawn, babysit your friends baby or bake a cake for your colleagues birthday all in return for a small donation.
- **Create your own cookbook** – made up of friends' and family's recipes and sell it to as many people as possible.
- **Pampering delights** – organise a pampering evening for your friends or work colleagues – enjoyable, relaxing and a good fundraiser!
- **'Come dine with me'** – why not organise a 'come dine with me' evening at home with your friends? Ask all of your friends for a £5 donation.
- **Sponsorship gifts** – ask for sponsorship instead of gifts for your birthday or Christmas this year.

At work

- **Sweepstake** – organise a sweepstake at work and use half the money as a prize and use the rest towards your sponsorship.
- **Who's the baby competition** – ask your colleagues to bring in a photograph of themselves as a baby, and then charge everyone £2 to guess who's who. You could even have a prize for the lucky winner!
- **Sweet Wednesdays** – why not bake a selection of cakes one day a week and ask your colleagues for a donation?
- **Organise an event** – for your work colleagues such as a dress down day, charging £1 to each person who takes part.
- **Don't say that!** – introduce a bleep bucket at work where offenders pay a 50p donation into the bucket every time they 'loosen their tongue'!



At home and around

- **Plant and craft sale** – you could sell pink cakes, jams, chutney, pastries, knitting and even your own flowers and plants.
- **BBQ** – organise a BBQ for all your neighbours and ask them for a donation for a hot dog, beef burger or drink. You could even hold tombola.
- **Packing up** – ask your local supermarket if you can pack customers' shopping bags for a small donation. This is a real winner!
- **Tug of war** – ask your friends, family and work colleagues to enter a team and then ask for donations for spectators to come and watch
- **Car boot sale** – have a clear out and take your old things to a local car boot sale. You'll be surprised how much money you can make! Why not join forces with a friend
