



The Show London 2017 Terms of Sale

These terms and conditions apply to your attendance at The Show London event on Thursday 28 September 2017 at the Park Plaza Westminster Bridge Hotel and for all associated transactions.

Attendance is conditional on acceptance of these terms and conditions.

Attendance

To attend The Show London 2017 event, attendees must have a valid ticket and valid ID on their persons for entry.

Attendees must be over the age of 18.

Breast Cancer Care and associated companies reserve the right to refuse entry and/or ask attendees to leave the event. In particular, but without limitation, for any of the following reasons: for health and safety or licensing reasons; if attendees behave in a manner which has or is likely to affect the enjoyment of other persons at the event; if attendees use threatening, abusive or insulting words or mannerisms; if, in the organisers' reasonable opinion, attendees are acting under the influence of alcohol or drugs; if attendees fail, when required, to produce proof of identity of age; if attendees refuse to comply with the security's searches.

Ticket cancellations and refunds

Ticket cancellations must be made in writing and sent to theshow@breastcancercare.org.uk and are subject to the following terms. Full refunds will be offered for cancellations made up to ten weeks before the event (i.e. on or before 20 July 2017) on all tickets. For cancellations made up to six weeks before the event (i.e. on or before 17 August 2017) a 50% refund is available on all tickets. After 17 August 2017, we are unfortunately not able to offer any ticket refunds.

Event cancellation

Breast Cancer Care reserves the right to cancel the event at any time at its sole discretion. In the event of a cancellation by Breast Cancer Care, we will refund the full value of the ticket already received by Breast Cancer Care from attendees or offer an exchange for a re-scheduled date. Breast Cancer Care will not be liable for any other direct or indirect costs and expenses (such as travel, accommodation and other associated costs) incurred by attendees as a result of any such cancellation.

In the event of a cancellation, we will use reasonable endeavours to contact attendees personally, through the contact details given to us at the time of booking.
